HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 651, L.D. 2056, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain Provisions in the Education Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 12 a new section to read:

'Sec. 12-A. 20 MRSA §859, as amended,  
< is further amended by adding after the 3rd ¶ the following new paragraph:

'Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, a pupil who has been enrolled in kindergarten or grade 1 in another state shall be admitted to kindergarten or grade 1, respectively, upon transfer to a school in this State.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit a pupil who has been enrolled in kindergarten or grade 1 in another state to transfer to Maine despite the 5 and 6 year old age requirements of this State.
