HOUSE AMENDMENT " D" to S.P. 651, L.D. 2056, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain Provisions in the Education Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 10 by striking out all of the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:
'The school committee may authorize the principal to suspend students up to a maximum of 10 days for infractions of school rules.'

Further amend said Bill in section 10 by inserting at the end the following blocked paragraph:

'Any student suspended shall, upon his return to school, be permitted to do any schoolwork uncompleted due to the suspension. The completion of this work shall be subject to reasonable schedules established by the school committee or school directors.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit students who have been suspended from school to make up work which they have missed because of the suspension. The schedule for the make up work will be established by the school committee of each unit.
