SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 651, L.D. 2056, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify Certain Provisions in the Education Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 12 the following:

'Sec. 12-A. 20 MRSA §912, first ¶, as last amended by

PL 1967, c. 425, §19, is further amended by inserting at the end the following new sentence:

Whenever any administrative unit sends elementary pupils to another administrative unit, the receiving school committee may establish a tuition rate. The rate established shall not exceed the actual elementary per pupil cost for the year immediately preceding the year for which the rate is established.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to enact a limit on the amount of increase which may be charged for elementary school tuition.
