COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1881, L.D. 2059, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Public Inspection of Certain Juvenile
Court Records."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'15 MRSA §2606, 3rd sentence is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The juvenile court record may be maintained in any place provided that it shall not be open to the inspection of the general public except when such record pertains to a conviction or acquittal for criminal homicide in the first or 2nd degree or for conviction or acquittal of a Class A crime as defined by Title 17-A.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is clarification of the situation when the provisions of this Bill would be applicable.
