COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1881, L.D. 2059, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Public Inspection of Certain Juvenile
Court Records."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'15 MRSA §2606, 3rd sentence is repealed and the following
enacted in place thereof:

The juvenile court record may be maintained in any place provided
that it shall not be open to the inspection of the general public
except when such record pertains to a conviction or acquittal for
criminal homicide in the first or 2nd degree or for conviction
or acquittal of a Class A crime as defined by Title 17-A.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is clarification of the
situation when the provisions of this Bill would be applicable.
