STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX

AN ACT Relating to Public Inspection of Certain Juvenile Court Records.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

15 MRSA § 2606, 3rd sentence is amended to read:

The juvenile court record may be maintained in any place, provided that it shall not be open to the inspection of the general public unless such record pertains to a class A crime or other proceeding following a first offense.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit public inspection and disclosure of certain juvenile records involving class A crimes and proceedings other than a first offense.
