SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1885, L.D. 2063, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Allow Certain Mining Operations within the Sandy  
River and Temple Stream without a Permit from the Commissioner  
of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the  
period the following: ', unless the commissioner, after a  
public hearing preceded by reasonable public notice within  
90 days after the effective date of this section, makes a  
written finding, based upon evidence taken from all interested  
parties at the public hearing, that the mining permitted by  
this paragraph does not comply with the standards set forth in  
the first paragraph of section 2207. The decision of the  
commissioner shall be reviewable as to both questions of law  
and fact by the Superior Court of Kennebec County in accordance  
with the provisions of Rule 80-B of the Maine Rules of Civil  
Procedure'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to provide alternate  
procedures for regulating mining operations on Sandy River.
