COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 649, L.D. 2066, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to the Refund of Fees on Certain Unused Semi-  
trailer Registrations."

Amend said Bill in the title by striking out the words  
"of Fees"

after the enacting clause  
Further amend said Bill in the 7th line/(6th line of L.D.)  
by striking out everything after the underlined words "is returned"  
and inserting in place thereof the following: 'with an affidavit  
that the plate has never been used and the Secretary of State is  
satisfied that the plate has never been used, the prorata amount,  
based upon the remaining years of validity at the time of surrender  
of plate and registration certificate, shall be refunded.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to more clearly define the  
refund provisions relating to semi permanent plates for semitrailers.

This amendment also reduces the loss to the General Highway  
Fund from \$20,000 for each full fiscal year to a one-time loss of  
approximately \$13,000 plus minimal amounts in subsequent years.
