STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX

AN ACT to Permit Transit Districts to Establish and Maintain Waterborne Transportation Systems.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 4971, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1965, c. 488, is amended to read:

The district so formed shall be a body politic and corporate, may sue, be sued, plead and be impleaded, adopt a name, adopt and alter a common seal, and do all things necessary to furnish motor vehicle or waterborne mass transportation within said district, including charter service, for public purposes in the interest of public health, safety, comfort and convenience of the inhabitants of the municipality or municipalities comprising such district.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit transit districts to establish and maintain waterborne transportation systems.
