HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 663, L.D. 2087, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish the Dates of Legislative Sessions and to Clarify Laws Relating to Expenses of Legislators."

Amend said Amendment in section 1 by striking out in that part designated "§2." all of the first sentence "Each Member of the Senate and House of Representatives, beginning with the first Wednesday of January , 1975, shall receive \$3,750 in the first year and \$1,000 in the 2nd year of each biennium." and inserting in place thereof the following stricken out sentence 'Each-Member-of-the-Senate-and-House-of-Representative beginning-with-the-first-Wednesday-of-January- 7-19757-shall receive-\$3,750-in-the-first-year-and-\$1,000-in-the-2nd-year-of-each biennium-'

Further amend said Amendment in section 1 by striking out in that part designated "52." all of the 7th and 8th lines and inserting in place thereof the following: 'beginning-with-the first-Wednesday-of-January,-1977-and-thereafter, shall receive \$5,000 \$3,750 in the first'

Statement of Fact

This amendment, by continuing the current legislative salaries into future bienniums, will save the State \$223,125 for each biennium.
