Amend said amendment by striking out all of the first 11
lines after the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §2, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 51,
is further amended to read:

§2. Salary, expenses and travel of Members of the Legislature and
Representatives of Indian tribes

Each Member of the Senate and House of Representatives,
beginning with the first Wednesday ~~of January, 1975, shall receive~~
~~\$3,750 in the first year and \$1,000 in the 2nd year of each biennium.~~
~~Each Member of the Senate and House of Representatives, beginning~~
~~with the first Wednesday~~ after the first Tuesday of January, 1977
and thereafter, shall receive \$5,000 \$3,750 in the first year
and \$1,000 in the 2nd year of each biennium, and shall be'
