Sessions and to Clarify Laws Relating to Expenses of Legislators."


7th line,
Amend said Amendment in the 3rd paragraph, by striking out
the figure "\$1,000" and inserting in place thereof the following:
'~~\$1,000~~ \$2,000'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of the
6th paragraph which relates to per diem for the 2nd regular
session of the Legislature.

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes the provision for per diem during
the 2nd regular session and sets the pay for the 108th Legislature
at a total of \$7,000 for the biennium. By deleting the per
diem and increasing the 2nd year's pay to \$2,000, the net total
cost of the biennial legislative payroll would be decreased
about \$46,000 from the level of Committee Amendment "A."
