#### AN ACT Clarifying the Right-to-Know Statute.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 1 MRSA § 404, sub-§ 6, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 422, § 2, is repealed.

Sec. 2. I MRSA § 405-C, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 483, § 5, is amended to read:

Such appeals may shall be privileged in respect to their assignment for trial over all other actions except writs of habeas corpus or actions brought by the State against individuals.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals an ambiguous section of the present Right-to-Know Law and corrects an inconsistency in another section of the law.
