AN ACT Clarifying the Right-to-Know Statute.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 1 MRSA § 404, sub-§ 6, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 422, § 2, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 1 MRSA § 405-C, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 483, § 5, is amended to read:

Such appeals ~~may~~ shall be privileged in respect to their assignment for trial over all other actions except writs of habeas corpus or actions brought by the State against individuals.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals an ambiguous section of the present Right-to-Know Law and corrects an inconsistency in another section of the law.
