HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1906, L.D. 2093, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Municipal Appropriations to Incorporated
Volunteer Fire Departments."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. 30 MRSA §5102, sub-§4, ¶A, as amended by PL 1967,
C. 329, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

A. When a sum has been appropriated for the use of an
incorporated volunteer fire department, the municipal
officers may retain the appropriation under municipal
control to be disbursed in the same manner as moneys
appropriated for other municipal operations;

Sec. 2. 30 MRSA §5102, sub-§4, ¶B is enacted to read:

B. In the alternative to the disbursal method provided
in paragraph A ←→ and upon vote of the local governing
body, the municipal officers may issue their warrant to
the municipal treasurer requiring him to pay the full
amount of the appropriation → to the
treasurer of the volunteer fire department.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will permit 2 methods of handling municipal appropriations to incorporated volunteer fire departments:

1. Upon a vote of the local governing body, the payment by the municipal treasurer of all ~~of~~ of the appropriation to the treasurer of the volunteer fire department, or
2. The disbursement of the appropriation by municipal officers to the fire department in the same manner as moneys are disbursed to other municipal operations.
