# STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX

AN ACT Concerning Municipal Appropriations to Incorporated Volunteer Fire Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 5102, sub-§ 4,  $\P$  A, as amended by PL 1967, c. 329, is further amended to read:

**A.** When a sum not in excess of  $f_{\pm,000}$  has been appropriated for the use of the department, the municipal officers may issue their warrant to the municipal treasurer requiring him to pay the amount of the appropriation to the treasurer of the volunteer fire department;

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

Title 30, section 5102 presently states that when a municipality appropriates a sum not exceeding \$1,000 to an incorporated volunteer fire department, the municipal officers may issue their warrant to the municipal treasurer requiring him to pay the amount of the appropriation to the treasurer of the volunteer fire department. This bill removes the \$1,000 limit as that limit is unreasonable in view of the present costs of operating volunteer fire departments.
