**AN ACT Designating March 15th as Maine Day.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

1 MRSA § 116 is enacted to read:

**§ 116. Maine Day**

March 15th of each year shall be designated as Maine Day, and the Governor shall annually issue a proclamation inviting and urging the people of the State of Maine to observe the day in schools and other suitable places with appropriate ceremony and activity. Maine Day shall commemorate the admission of Maine as a state into the United States of America and the ideals and wisdom of those men and women who have formed Maine's history and traditions. The Department of Educational and Cultural Services shall make appropriate information available to the people and the schools within the limits of its budget.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill establishes Maine Day as a day of commemoration of Maine's admission into the Union and of the people of Maine who have helped form the state's history and traditions.
