'12. Reduction in allotment. The allocation determined pursuant to this section for each municipality or district shall be reduced by the amount of revenue that can be raised in the municipality or the municipalities constituting the district if a tax were assessed and collected at the rate of 14.5 mills applied to the municipality's state valuation adjusted to 100% in effect for the year in which the allocation is made.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove unnecessary language from the committee amendment "A".
