STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX

AN ACT Concerning Allowances Granted to Indian Representatives During Special Sessions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

3. MRSA § 2, 6th ¶, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 781, § 1, is further amended by adding a new sentence after the first sentence to read:

For the duration of any special session of the Legislature, they shall receive the same allowances, including housing, meal and constituent service allowances, as any other member of the Senate and House of Representatives.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to authorize the same reimbursement of the expenses of Indian Representatives during any special session of the Legis-lature which any other member of the Legislature would receive.
