# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX

### AN ACT to Clarify the Definition of Supervisor as it Appears in the Maine Retirement Statutes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA § 1001, sub-§ 10, first sentence, as last amended by PL 1969, c. 504, § 11-A, is further amended to read:

"Employee" shall mean any regular classified or unclassified officer or employee in a department, including, for the purposes of this chapter, teachers in the public schools, and salaried supervisors in the public schools, but shall not include any Justice of the Superior Court or Supreme Judicial Court who is now or may be later entitled to retirement benefits under Title 4, section 5, and Title 4, section 103, nor shall it include any Judge of the District Court who is now or may be later entitled to retirement benefits under Title 4, chapter 5, nor shall it include any member of the State Police who is now entitled to retirement benefits under Title 25, chapter 195.

Sec. 2. 5 MRSA § 1001, sub-§ 27, is enacted to read:

27. Salaried supervisors. "Salaried supervisors" shall mean any salaried supervisor of a department or office who meets the requirements for an executive, administrative, professional and outside salesman exemptions under part 541 of the Federal Fair Labor Standards Act.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to clarify the definition of supervisor as it appears in the definition of employee and teacher.
