STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-SIX

AN ACT Authorizing Funds for the Purchase of Certain
Lands Adjoining the Capitol Complex.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Finance and Administration, Bureau of Public Improvements, the sum of \$30,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1977. In order to provide for the purchasing of the Marilyn Young property at 19 Capitol Street in Augusta, Maine, the following sums, or as much thereof as shall be found necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the General Fund not otherwise appropriated. The breakdown shall be as follows:
