## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX

#### AN ACT Relating to Conferring Degrees By Thomas College.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Degrees. In addition to the rights, privileges and powers granted to Thomas College, by the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 54 and by the private and special laws of 1959, chapter 117, and by the private and special laws of 1963, chapter 72, and by the private and special laws of 1963, chapter 61, and by the private and special laws of 1973, chapter 203, said Thomas College, by appropriate action of its trustees, may confer upon all who shall satisfactorily complete such courses of study as those trustees may prescribe, within the scope customarily established by colleges offering a graduate curriculum, the degree of Master of Business Administration.
- Sec. 2. Effective date. The first degree of Master of Business Administration shall be awarded no earlier than May, 1978.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to grant the conferring of degrees of Master of Business Administration at Thomas College.
