AN ACT Increasing Borrowing Capacity of Community School District Consisting of the Towns of Crystal, Dyer Brook, Island Falls, Merrill, Oakfield and Smyrna.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P & SL 1973, c. 26, 1st sentence is amended to read:

The school trustees of the community school district consisting of the Towns of Crystal, Dyer Brook, Island Falls, Merrill, Oakfield and Smyrna are authorized to borrow a sum of money not in excess of ~~\$1,100,000~~ \$1,530,000.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the borrowing capacity from \$1,100,000 to \$1,530,000 for the community school district consisting of the Towns of Crystal, Dyer Brook, Island Falls, Merrill, Oakfield and Smyrna.
