## STATE OF MAINE SENATE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION 107TH LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 667, L.D. 2119, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify Certain Provisions of the Newport Water
District Charter."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Town of Newport will be able to vote on the exercising of these new powers in June of 1976; and

Whereas, without emergency enactment this Act will not become effective prior to this time; and

Whereas, the exercising of these powers will thus be seriously delayed if no emergency enactment is made; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill.
