SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1933, L.D. 2121, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Sec. 5-A. 12 MRSA §2456, 2nd ¶, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1971, c. 300, §1, is amended to read:

Notwithstanding this section, paraplegics, single or double amputees of the legs may hunt from motor vehicles which are not in motion.

Sec. 5-B. 12 MRSA §2469 is enacted to read:

§2469. Discharge of firearm near dwelling

It shall be unlawful to discharge a firearm within 100 feet of a residential dwelling without the permission of the owner or, in his absence, of an adult occupant of that dwelling.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment permits a single amputee to hunt from a motor vehicle which is not in motion and makes it unlawful to discharge a firearm within 100 feet of a residential dwelling without the owner's permission.
