STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX

AN ACT to Redefine the Administration of Medication in the Nursing Practice Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 32 MRSA § 2102, sub-§ 2, ¶ D, as amended by PL 1973, c. 495, § 1, is further amended to read:
 - D. Administration of medications and treatment as prescribed by a licensed physician or dentist except that the administration of medication shall not be construed to include the offering of the prescribed medication to the individual for whom prescribed for his consumption in accordance with the directions on the individual container in his name.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Correctional facilities, jails, foster homes, etc. do not have licensed professional nurses to give prescribed medication to people located in these facilities. This Act exempts from defined nursing practice, such an act as taking a bottle of medicine prescribed for an individual, giving him the prescribed dose and assuring that it was taken in accordance with the directions on the medicine bottle.
