HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
S.P. 668, L.D. 2127, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the
Administration of Medicine to Inmates of County Jails."

Amend said amendment in that part designated
"§912." by striking out all of subsection 3 and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'3. Insulin injections. No provisions under this
section shall prevent any prisoner from self-administering
insulin injections providing:

A. A duly licensed physician has authorized such
self-administration; and

B. Such self-administration takes place in the
presence of the sheriff or his delegate.'

This amendment concerns the self-administration of
insulin by a prisoner.
