COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1945, L.D. 2131, Bill,
"AN ACT Prohibiting the Use of Seine or Gill Nets on a Certain
Portion of the Union River."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'12 MRSA §4213 is enacted to read:

§4213. Use of seine or gill nets on Union River

It shall be unlawful, from May 1st to October 31st of each
year, for anyone to use a seine or gill net in the Union River
above a line drawn from Weymouth Point in the Town of Surry to
the Ellsworth-Trenton town line on the east side of the Union
River.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment makes it unlawful, from May 1st to October
31st of each year, to use a seine or gill net in the Union River
above a line drawn from Weymouth Point in the Town of Surry to
the Ellsworth-Trenton town line on the east side of the Union
River.
