**AN ACT Restricting the Use of Motor Driven Boats on Certain Areas of
Penobscot River.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2085 is enacted to read:

§ 2085. —Portions of the Penobscot River

No person, except a law enforcement official or those assisting a law enforcement official, shall operate a motorboat on the Penobscot River from the Bangor Dam to a line drawn perpendicular to the portion of the riverbank immediately upriver from the boat landing of the Penobscot County Conservation Club across to the other side of the Penobscot River.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits the operation of a motorboat on the Penobscot River from the Bangor Dam to the boat landing of the Penobscot County Conservation Club.
