COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1949, L.D. 2135, Bill,
"AN ACT Appropriating Funds for the Purchase of Town Histories."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in the 3rd line (same in L.D.) by striking out the figure "\$18,050" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$19,400'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 10th line (9th line in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All Other \$19,400'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting at the end the following:

'China, Maine: A Bicentennial History	100 copies	600
An Illustrated History of the City of Bangor: 1775-1975	150 copies	750'
