AN ACT Appropriating Funds for the Purchase of Town Histories.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. State Library; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services the sum of \$18,050 for fiscal year 1976-77 to be used to purchase copies of town histories listed below. The breakdown shall be as follows:
