COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1950, L.D. 2136, Bill,
"AN ACT to Allow the Board of Environmental Protection to
Grant Limited Variances to Statutory Time Schedules."

Amend said Bill by striking out the entire emergency
preamble and emergency clause.

Further amend said Bill by striking out the first para-
graph of that part designated "\$451-B" and inserting in place
thereof the following:

'The Board of Environmental Protection may grant a variance
from any statutory water pollution time schedule to any indus-
trial licensee, upon application by any industrial licensee,
if the board finds that:'

Statement of Fact

This amendment makes the granting of variances permissive
instead of mandatory and makes variances available to all
industrial licensees.

In addition, the amendment removes the emergency preamble
and clause.
