HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1950, L.D. 2136, Bill,
"AN ACT to Allow the Board of Environmental Protection to Grant
Limited Variances to Statutory Time Schedules."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph
before the emergency clause and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'Variances shall be issued for a term certain, not to extend
past January 31, 1977, and the board shall modify any existing
license to make it consistent with this variance.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment limits the extension proposed by the bill
to January 31, 1977. Most industries have indicated that they
could meet the original deadline of October 1, 1976, barring
unforeseen delays. Therefore, a 4-month extension to account for
these unforeseen delays should be ample. Any additional
extension should be granted by the 108th Legislature in light of
the current circumstances.
