Amend said amendment in section 2 by striking out in paragraph
A of subsection 1 of that part designated "§321." the following:
"3 municipalities" and inserting in place thereof the following:
'one municipality'

Further amend said amendment in section 2 by striking out in
paragraph C of subsection 1 of that part designated "§321." the
following: "2%" and inserting in place thereof the following:
'5%'

in section 2
Further amend said amendment/by striking out in paragraph B
of subsection 1 of that part designated "§322." the following:
"2%" and inserting in place thereof the following: '5%'

Further amend said amendment in section 2 by striking out
in the first sentence of subsection 3 of that part designated
"§322." the following: "3 municipalities" and inserting in place
thereof the following: 'one municipality'

Further amend said amendment in section 2 by striking out all
of the 3rd sentence of subsection 2 of that part designated "§323."
and inserting in place thereof the following:
'The circulator of such petition shall certify his belief that the
signatures on it are genuine and that the signers are registered
voters.'

in section 2
Further amend said amendment/by striking out all of the
last sentence of subsection 2 of that part designated "§323."
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Such petitions shall be filed in the Office of the Secretary of
State on or before 5 p.m. on the 180th day before a primary
election and shall contain the signatures and legal addresses of
voters who are equal in number to at least 5% of the total vote
cast in the State for Governor at the last preceding gubernatorial
election.'

Further amend said amendment in section 2 by striking out in
the first sentence of subsection 4 of that part designated "§323."
the following: "3 municipalities" and inserting in place thereof
the following: 'one municipality'
