HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1982, L.D. 2151, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Voting Places in Certain Unorganized
Townships."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 5 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 5. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the
General Fund to the Secretary of State the sum of \$1,600
to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown
shall be as follows:
