HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1982, L.D. 2151, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Voting Places in Certain Unorganized
Townships."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of paragraph
B of subsection 1 of that part designated "§1573."

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by ~~relettering~~ paragraphs
C and D of subsection 1 of that part designated "§1573." to be
paragraphs B and C.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 3 to 5 to be
2 to 4.

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes from the bill that section affecting
Penobscot County, and deletes from the bill the repealer of the
current statutory section which provides that Kingman shall have
a separate voting place.
