**AN ACT Authorizing Central Maine General Hospital School of Nursing to
Confer Associate Degrees in Nursing.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Central Maine General Hospital School of Nursing; Associate Degrees. Central Maine General Hospital School of Nursing, a corporation, organized exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes as a nonprofit organization, shall have power and authority to confer Associate Degrees in Nursing upon all persons who shall have completed satisfactorily a 2-year course of study in the field of nursing. Such degrees shall not be conferred until June, 1977.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to authorize Central Maine General Hospital School of Nursing of Lewiston to confer Associate Degrees in Nursing.
