COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B " to H.P. 1966, L.D. 2155, Bill, "AN ACT Regarding the Rights of Students at the University of Maine in the University Bargaining Process."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 4 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'4. Students. When collective bargaining is to take place between the university and the faculty or professional and administrative staff, the board of trustees shall appoint 3 currently enrolled students who are broadly representative of the various campuses in the university system and who may meet and confer with the bargaining agent prior to collective bargaining. In addition to its responsibilities to the public generally, the university shall have the specific responsibility of considering and representing the interests and welfare of the students in any negotiations under this chapter.'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to require the university bargaining team to meet and confer with students and to consider and represent the interests and welfare of students in negotiations.
