SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1983, L.D. 2165, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Charitable Solicitations."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of paragraph B of subsection 1 of that part designated "\$5005." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'B. A corporation sole or other religious corporation, trust, society or organization incorporated or established for religious purposes which is exempt from federal taxation pursuant to section 501, (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended.'


Further amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting at the end of subsection 1 of that part designated "\$5005." the following:

'E. Public and private educational institutions located within this State; organizations operated by the student bodies of such institutions; and hospitals licensed by the Department of Human Services and exempt from federal taxation pursuant to section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt from the provisions of the registration requirements of the Charitable

Solicitations Act public and private educational institutions located in the State of Maine, their student bodies, hospitals which are licensed by the State of Maine and which have been determined to be tax exempt by the Federal Government and religious organizations which are also tax exempt.
