SENATE AMENDMENT "C " to H.P. 1983, L.D. 2165, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Charitable Solicitations."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§5005." in subsection 1 by adding at the end a new paragraph F
to read:

'F. Any council of the Boy Scouts of America, of the Girl
Scouts of America or of the Camp Fire Girls of America
which is incorporated in this State, unless that council
has solicited contributions by use of a professional fund-
raising counsel, in which case the council shall file
registration statements covering those contributions
received as a direct result of that solicitation.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment exempts from the requirement of filing
registration statements under the bill any council of the Boy
Scouts of America, the Girl Scouts of America or the Camp Fire
Girls of America, which are incorporated in Maine. The amendment
further provides, however, that if those councils raise contributions
through the use of professional fund-raising counsel, then they
shall file registration statements covering those contributions.
