SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 677, L.D. 2166, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Personnel System."

Amend said Bill in section 4 in that part designated
"§631." by adding a new paragraph at the end of subsection
7 to read:

'The head of each state department and agency shall appoint
one person employed in such department or agency who shall
administer the Personnel Law as it applies to such department
or agency, and shall notify the Director of Personnel of
such appointment. In administering the Personnel Law, such
person shall be subject to the direction of, and shall be
responsible and report to, the Director of Personnel.'

The purpose of this amendment is to assure systematic
and uniform application of the Personnel Law in State Government.
