HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1981,
LD. 2170, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution
to Permit the Governor to Veto Items Contained in Bills
Appropriating Money.

Amend said amendment by striking out in the 2nd line of
the 3rd paragraph the following: "or reduce" and by striking
out in the 6th line of the 3rd paragraph the following:
"or which he has reduced"

Further amend said amendment by striking out in the
21st line of the 3rd paragraph the following: "or has
reduced"

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes from the committee amendment the
power of the Governor to reduce one or more items of appropri-
ation of money in a bill. This amendment leaves intact the
Governor's ability to object to one or more items of
appropriation of money in a bill.
