COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1992, L.D. 2174, Bill,
"AN ACT to Classify the Positions of Director of Program Review
and Evaluation in the Department of Audit, Director of Fraud
Investigation in the Department of Audit, and of Employees of
the Fraud Investigation Division in the Department of Audit."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, legislation is pending to reclassify certain positions in the Department of Audit and to transfer positions from the Department of Audit to the Department of Human Services and to the Attorney General's office; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to put an emergency on the bill.
