HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1992, L.D. 2174, Bill,
"AN ACT to Classify the Positions of Director of Program Review
and Evaluation in the Department of Audit, Director of Fraud Investiga-
tion in the Department of Audit, and of Employees of the Fraud
Investigation Division in the Department of Audit."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and
inserting in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT to Classify
the Position of Director of Program Review and Evaluation in the
Department of Audit.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §242-B, sub-§1, 2nd and 3rd sentences,
as enacted by PL 1973, c. 792, §3, are repealed and the following
enacted in place thereof:

He shall employ, subject to the Personnel Law, a director
of that division.

Sec. 2. Transitional provision. The State Personnel Board
is directed to amend the compensation plan of the State of Maine,
as provided in the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 634, so
that the Director of Program Review and Evaluation of the
Department of Audit shall be placed in the state classified system
and shall be accorded the benefits provided in the Revised
Statutes, Title 5, section 634.

Sec. 3. Transfer of present personnel to classified status.

The person employed on the effective date of this Act as Director of Program Review and Evaluation of the Department of Audit shall be deemed to have qualified under the Personnel Law for employment in his respective position on the effective date of this Act, shall not be required by the Personnel Board to undergo any testing or competitive selection procedure as a prerequisite for holding his respective position and shall hold his respective position under the Personnel Law on the effective date of this Act.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the Director of Program Review and Evaluation in the Department of Audit be subject to the Personnel Law.
