COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 683, L.D. 2189, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Extend the Interim Zoning in Areas of Franklin and  
Somerset Counties."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 5 lines  
before the Emergency clause (same in L.D.) and inserting in  
place thereof the following:

'Interim districts and land use standards shall be effective no  
more than 36 48 months from the date first adopted. The  
adoption of permanent districts or land use standards shall  
supersede interim districts or standards.'

Statement of Fact

Instead of having one particular termination date for interim  
districts and land use standards established, this amendment  
provides for a standard term of 48 months for each interim  
district and land use standard adopted.
