SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2009, L.D. 2191, Bill,  
"AN ACT Concerning Single Motor Vehicle Registration Plates and  
Placement of Motor Vehicle Inspection Stickers."

Amend said Bill in section 19 by striking out all of the  
last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Commencing October 1, 1976, all front plates except  
for those of truck-tractors may be removed at such time as  
registration for 1977 is accomplished. When the registrations for  
truck-tractors expire in 1977, the rear plate may be removed.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section  
21

Further amend said Bill by renumbering section 22 of the bill to 1  
section 21.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the House  
Amendment "A" making it permissive rather than mandatory to remove  
the existing front plate and / <sup>permitting</sup> the display of initial plates.  
By deleting section 21 it allows present law to prevail, thus  
avoiding conflict with existing federal statutes regarding  
placement of inspection stickers for interstate truckers.
