SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 686, L.D. 2195, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise Statutory Provisions Relating to Dropouts."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause
the following:

'Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §2611, as last amended by PL 1975,
c. 538, §§2 to 7, is further amended by adding at the
end the following new sentence:

This paragraph shall not apply to habitual truancy by a
juvenile under Title 20, chapter 105.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 1 and
2 to be 2 and 3.

Statement of Fact

This amendment addresses itself to the problems of
hundreds of Maine youngsters who are functional drop-outs
through habitual truancy. As the ultimate procedure it would
authorize the court to assign a juvenile to the Boys' Training
Center.
