HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "L" to H.P. 2020, L.D. 2196, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Laws Relating to Funding of Public Schools."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 7th and 8th paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Further  
/amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§3747." by striking out all of the last sentence of subsection 6 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Legislature shall appropriate no more than 90% of the amounts established for paragraphs E and F, subparagraph (1) of subsection 3.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§3748." by striking out all of the last sentence of subparagraph (1) of paragraph C of subsection 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Reimbursement for special education programs operated or contracted for by the administrative unit shall be limited to the estimated costs or the actual expenditures, whichever is less.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for reimbursement to administrative units for 100% of the costs of special education programs operated by or contracted for by the local unit.
