HOUSE AMENDMENT"A"to HOUSE AMENDMENT"O" to H.P. 2020,  
L.D. 2196, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Laws Relating to  
Funding of Public Schools."

Amend said amendment by striking out all of paragraphs  
the 7th and 8th paragraphs and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

'Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part  
designated "§3747." in subsection 6 in the next to the last  
line (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined letter  
and punctuation "C," and by inserting at the end before  
the period the following: 'and for subsection 4'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part  
designated "§3748." by striking out all of the last sentence  
of subparagraph (1) of paragraph C of subsection 1 and  
inserting in place thereof the following:  
'Reimbursement for special education programs operated  
or contracted for by the administrative unit shall be  
limited to the estimated costs or the actual expenditures,  
whichever is less.'

Fiscal Note

Increasing the reimbursement from 90% to 100% will cost an additional \$881,085 which will be funded from General Fund revenue sources.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for reimbursement to administrative units for 100% of the costs of special education programs operated by or contracted for by the local unit.
