HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1997, L.D. 2197, Bill,
"AN ACT Redistributing the Powers of the Executive Council."

Amend said Bill in section 109 by inserting in the 5th line (4th line of L.D.) after the stricken out words "~~and-Council~~" the underlined words and punctuation 'and subject to review by the Joint Standing Committee on Business Legislation and to confirmation by the Legislature,'

Further amend said Bill in section 259 by inserting in the last line (same in L.D.) after the stricken out words "~~and-Council~~" ^{underlined} the following/words 'and subject to review by the Joint Standing Committee on Business Legislation and to confirmation by the Legislature'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for review by the Joint Standing Committee on Business Legislation of the nominations for Superintendent of the Bureau of Consumer Protection and for Superintendent of Insurance and provides for confirmation of those nominations by the Legislature.
